How can we find persons of peace?

Kingdom Greetings: What “Kingdom greetings” (cf. Matt 10:12; Luke 10:5-6) might help identify a person of peace?

Experiment. Listen to the Lord. Be bold.

Pray at start of each day to meet a person of peace, for the Lord to give you eyes to ‘see’ them, even for those who will ask you a question revealing their spiritually open heart.

Prayer Walking...

Pray for people you see as you walk.
Look for people to engage in conversation.

Listen for the Spirit's prompting.

Listen for felt needs. Offer to pray...

Or ask, "If God could work a miracle in your life, what would it be?" If they respond with a need, pray on the spot for that miracle in Jesus' name.

Engaging Conversation: Learn more of their story / ask questions...

After praying, follow up with a question e.g.,

"What is your experience of God?" or

"Do you consider yourself to be near to God or far from God?"

If they engage in conversation, ask more questions to briefly discover their story and the reason(s) why they feel close to or far from or hunger for God.

Share your story & Jesus story


Once you learn their story, share your story.

E.g. you can ask, "Can I share the best thing that has ever happened to me?" (or first, "What is the best thing that has ever happened to you?"

As a part of your story, share the gospel message with them,

inviting the person of peace to follow Jesus.
